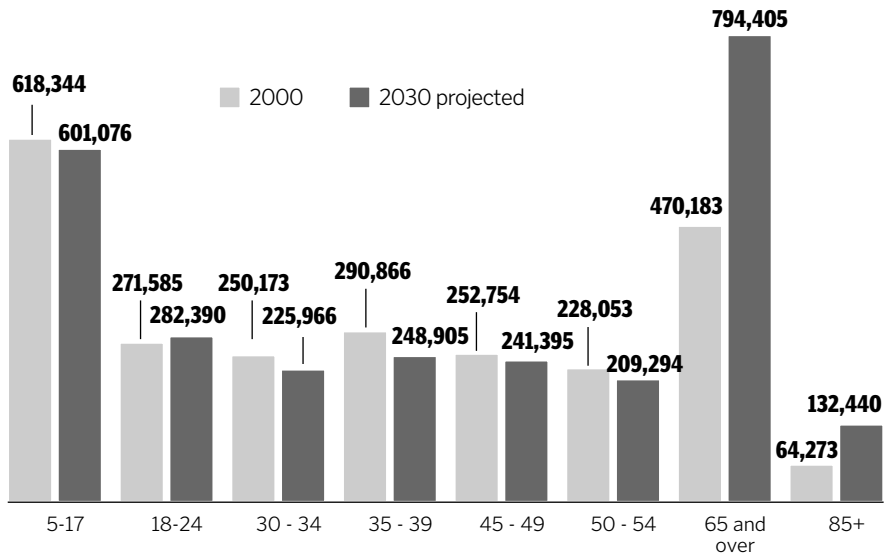


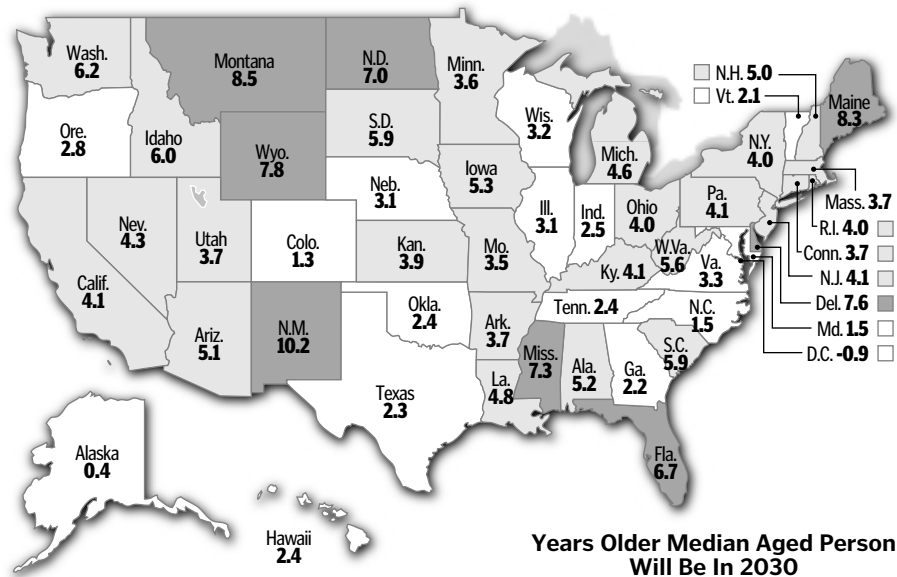
State In Transition

Connecticut is becoming a state where there will be fewer children and teenagers, and many more people aged 65 or older.

In 2000, no state had a median age older than 38 years. By 2030, the Census Bureau says the median age in 23 states will be older than 40. Many aging states are in the Northeast or Midwest, but several in the West and South are also aging rapidly.
