

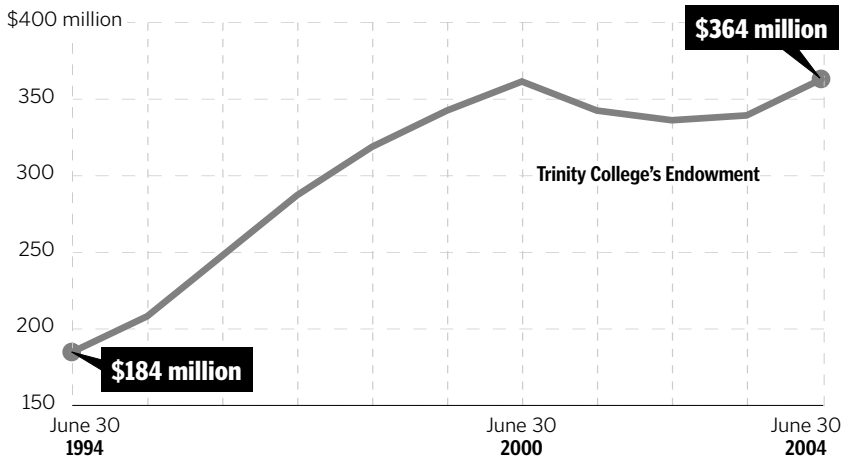
College Wealth

Compared to some of its peers, Trinity College has a relatively modest endowment. The endowment also did not grow as quickly between 2003 and the end of 2004 as many others, according to a national survey released in January by the National Association of College and University Business Officers.
