

RESOLUTION - ONE CITY, ONE PLAN

June 3, 2010

"One City, One Plan - POCD 2020" - Hartford's Plan of Conservation and Development

Whereas: Chapter 126, Section 8-23 of the Connecticut General Statutes requires that a Planning and Zoning Commission "prepare, adopt and amend a plan of conservation and development for the municipality" every ten (10) years; and

Whereas: The City of Hartford's Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a vigorous and robust update process as detailed in Chapter 1 of the subject document "One City, One Plan - POCD 2020"; and

Whereas: Over one thousand (1,000) individuals have participated and/or provided comments as part of this process; and

Whereas: Hartford's City Council unanimously endorsed the plan on April 26, 2010 pursuant to Section 8-23 (f)(2) of the Connecticut State Statutes; and

Whereas: The Capitol Region Council of Governments praised the plan in a letter dated April 16, 2010 pursuant to Section 8-23 (f)(4) of the Connecticut State Statutes; and

Whereas: The Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a formal public hearing on May 20, 2010; and

Whereas: "One City, One Plan" will be a vibrant living document to not only guide the future development of the City of Hartford, but to also serve as a guide for those entities responsible for implementing the plan; **Now, Therefore Be It**

Resolved: That the City of Hartford's Planning and Zoning Commission does hereby adopt the document titled: "One City, One Plan - POCD 2020" together with the Future Land Use Map dated June 3, 2010 on this third day of June, 2010 with an effective date of June 17, 2010.
