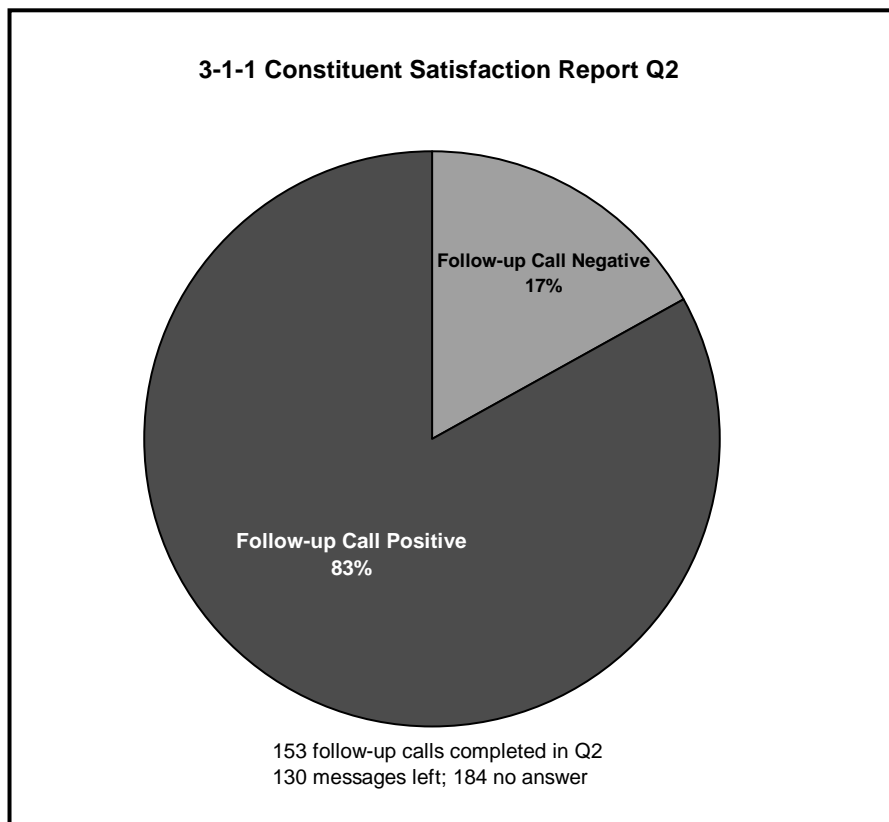

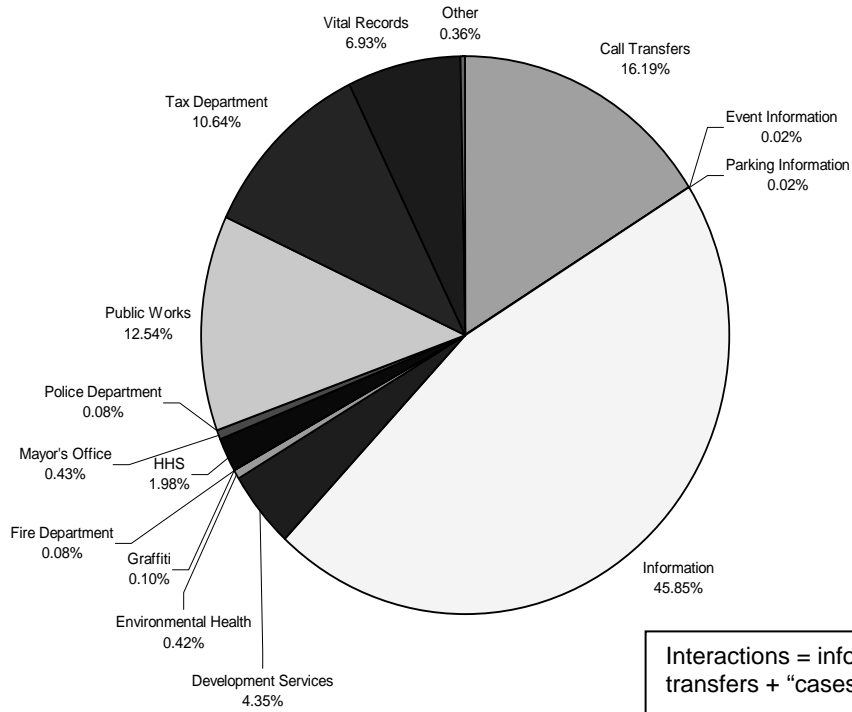

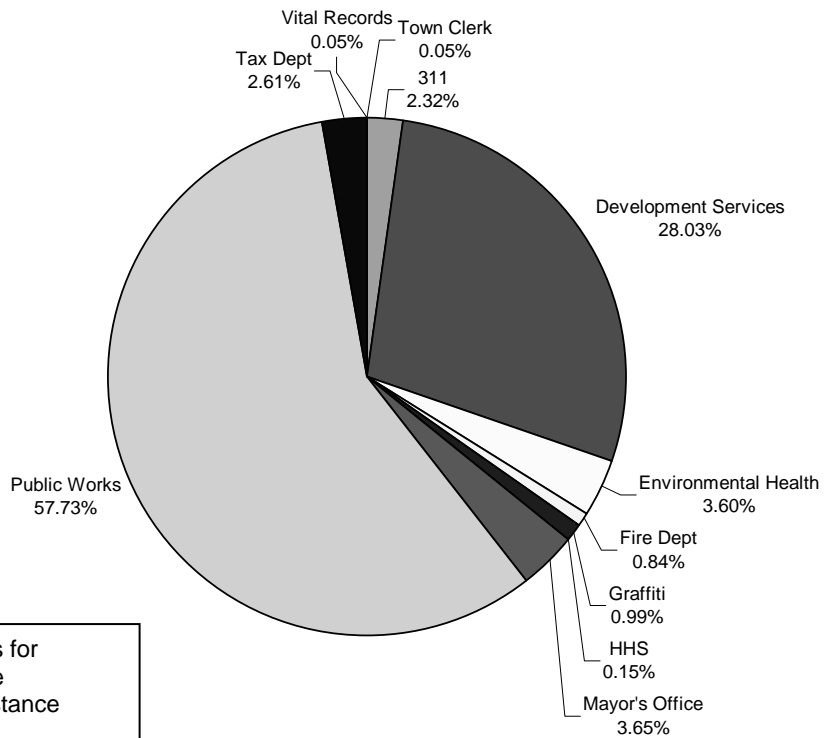


Interactions by Department Q2

Cases by Department Q2

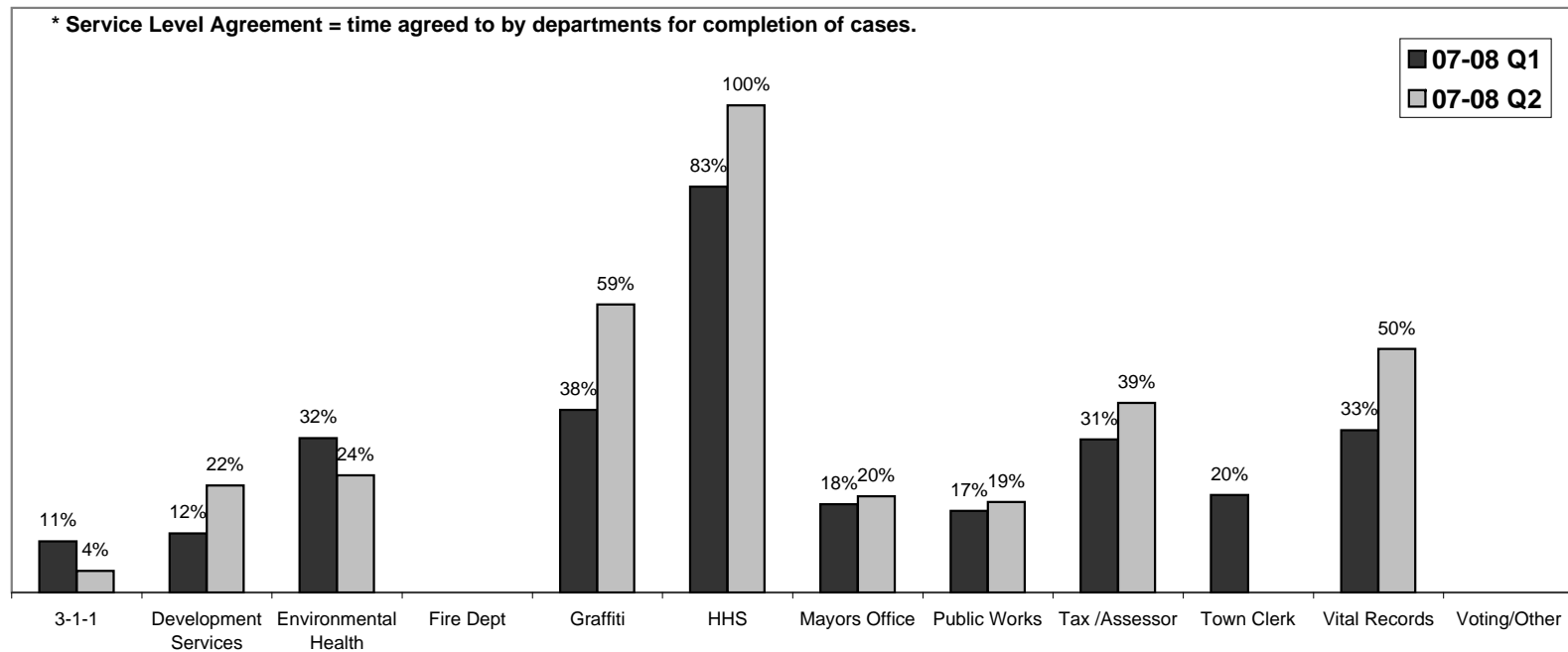
