



* Hartford's Street System is comprised of approximately 231 linear miles of streets. An estimated 19.7 miles are State routes, and 211.5 miles are the responsibility of the City. Approximately 125 miles are considered local streets, providing access to and within residential neighborhoods. There are 27 miles of collectors which circulate within neighborhoods and access commercial and industrial areas. Approximately 39 miles are arterials that serve to connect Hartford to outlying areas and provide access to major activity centers. All downtown streets are considered arterials and collectors.
